Applicants must be available to work a combination of day, evening and weekend shifts. Primarily evenings and weekends, however, bookings could be between 6:00 a.m. to midnight.

The Independent Living Assistant is responsible for delivering front-line support services as directed by clients and as set out in each client's service agreement, ensuring that client needs are met safely, efficiently and effectively.

- PSW certification is required.
- Experience in providing direct physical support services for adults with physical disabilities.

- Ability to meet the support service needs, as directed by the client.
- Ability to work independently and in a team environment.
- A physical requirement to be able to transfer clients.

- Effective verbal, written and listening communication skills.
